- A. Senate Fiscal Committee voted to approve all of the fee requests (included in last meeting's update)
- B. Colleges of Medicine and Optometry have proposed multi-year tuition proposals that would allow students to maintain a constant instructional fee throughout their four years (like a tuition guarantee).
 - a. Medicine's fee = \$15,062.00 /semester, \$30,124/year ranks 1 and 2 for res [starting in school year 2022-23, Ranks 1 and 2 will be aligned with that]
 - b. Optometry's fee = \$146,704 4-year total for res/non-res (\$36,676/year)


