    - College of Vet Med
      - There has been a 2% increase in tuition. This does not cover university obligations of raising employee salaries. College of Vet Med is putting a huge focus on trying to make attendance of their college affordable. So far \$2.1 million dollars worth of scholarships have been distributed. Their goal is to have \$5.3 million distributed per year, allowing 2nd and third years to be tuition-free. Out-of-state residents only have to pay out-of-state tuition their first year and afterwards, they will only have to pay the cost of in-state tuition +\$5 for the following years (same plan as College of Optometry).
