  - Gold Humanism Honors Society Supporting the 2019 Solidarity Week Interprofessional Breakfast
    - o Jessica Walpole, College of Medicine
    - Will take place in February
    - o National initiative for medicals schools to promote humanism in medicine/healthcare professions
      - Want to expand past OSUCOM and reach other schools for the first time
        - "Tell Me More campaign" = set of questions that you can ask to your patients to bring back compassionate side to medicine
      - Form to show how different fields can promote humanism in medicine
  - Buckeye Donuts + coffee
    - \$\$ will get split up between schools evenly
    - Given in lobbies of each respective school
  - Main event to reach students not in clinicals (most in Med Center)
    - Other events:
      - Wake and shake (granola bars, hot chocolate, coffee, music, dancing)
      - Cupcake making event
      - Speakers (preventing burnout)
      - Bravo campaign (photo booth)
  - Voting
    - o Comments:
      - ¾ of students being in class is rare (should lower) BUT would also include faculty/staff
      - Essentially duplicating Donut Days
        - We should just match what we do for our own donut days or give  $\frac{1}{2}$
      - Could be free advertising for us
      - This is still helping most of our schools
      - Lacking interaction between schools
    - Stipulations:
      - Funding should go towards Law and Vet Med
      - No funding of Nursing and Rehabilitation Services
      - Make it "Law appropriate"

- University Staff Advisory Committee (USAC) Proposal for University Senate
  - o Staff looking to increase their representation in University Senate
    - We were worried that student numbers would decrease
    - Staff perspective is crucial
      - Adding 5 new members
      - Decreasing 3 administrative spots and adding 2 more to University Senate
      - Changes % of representation but not actual number of IPC representatives
- A Resolution to Support the Creation of a Middle Eastern/North African (ME/NA) Category on University Documents
  - We currently lack at OSU the Middle-Eastern/North African category, so they are identifying as white or caucasian
    - Arab Dental Society
    - Cited core goals of OSU (i.e. greater inclusion, increasing student representation)
  - o Asking for IPC to recognize that this is a category and see if there is anything we can do about it
    - Encourage further efforts and spread the word
    - Want IPC backing
      - 1. Start with Diversity Committee
      - 2. Talk to Dean Lloyd
      - 3. Go through Senate Steering (Sarah) and/or submit to University Senate (LT goal)
  - Resolution Passes (Hand Vote all Yes)
  - University Research Committee Updates
    - CGS wanted 2 seats back
    - o 2 CGS, 1 IPC, 1 undergrad with stipulation that there is a quorum of faculty members
      - Concern: student's vote should be the same as a faculty member's vote

- Checks for Fall Cycle were processed over break, applicants should have notification e-mail
- Spring PDF Cycle opens 02/08/2019-2/22/2019
  - Events 09/21/2018-2/22/2019
- Presentation on Fall PDF Summary
  - PDF = funding to get students extracurricular career enrichment opportunities
  - Get \$5000 from Deans from each college and \$15,000 from Academic Affairs (\$18,000 this year)
    - Fall 2018: \$11,666 divided evenly among the 6 colleges + additional funding left over for each college
      - Each student limited to \$750 per academic year
  - Spring-Fall 2018 = 100 applications (\$60,000 requested)
    - Optometry (40% applications)
    - Pharmacy and Vet Med also high
    - Dental and Law tend to be lower
  - o Events that were funded (mostly service trips and conferences)
- Available funding rolling over to Spring
  - Lots of \$ leftover in Dentistry and Law
- Many Optometry students were upset with how much they were awarded (most only got ~10% of what they asked for)
  - Change to divvy up \$ allocation from Academic Affairs
