# I. Speakers:

- Buckeyes Without Borders
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Interprofessional Brigade that will set up a mobile clinic to provide free services
  - Pharmacy-led student organization
  - 20 licensed team of licensed professionals and health professional students
    - Last year: 10 pharmacy students, 2 medical students, 1 OT student
  - Location: Intibuca region of Honduras
  - When: March 9-17, 2019 (Spring Break Trip)
    - Itemized Budget from 2018 spent...
      - \$1130 on Medications
      - \$503.06 Medications from Uptown Pharmacy
      - \$125.00 Medications in Honduras
      - \$138.83 Airline baggage fees
        - \$200.00 Brigade T-shirts
          - Doesn't include \$900 brigade fee (covers meals, lodging, transportation to clinic) and flight
  - Asking for \$2000.00 worth of funding
    - Would relieve fundraising burden (\$2000.00) and be spent on buying medications
      - By offsetting the fundraising burden, they could offer more trips/year

- Governmental Affairs Update

- Affordability Committee Updates
  - Get together all hidden fees on GoogleDoc
  - Will talk to Financial Aid services of each school to track hidden fees
  - Creating a survey to submit to 3rd and 4th years of each professional school; also considering allowing more people to take survey (i.e. people who have had concerns with affordability in the past)
- Headspace
  - Able to decrease price from \$10 subscription to \$7
  - Thinking about spending \$700 of Halloween funds to buy app for 100 professional students
