- Fiscal Committee Updates:
  - Final conclusion in terms of non-resident surcharges: if you're a 2nd-4th year student in the school of Opt or Vet Med, then you don't have to have Ohio residency and it will only be a \$5 surcharge
  - If a college needs to increase tuition, the college must come before the fiscal community to request an increase and the justifications for the increase. Colleges will also be required to talk to the student body about the increase
  - Average standard college tuition increase: 2%
    - Only school to not have requested any increase is College of Medicine

    - We will aim to be more transparent and clear with the specific roles of a Senator moving forward
