Speakers:

- MD Camp asking for \$3600.
 - Arguments for more funding ~\$2000:
 - Camp aimed at increasing equity of students
 - Completely student run organization, so IP students DO benefit
 - We are the ones who help shape demographics of professional schools
 - Arguments against funding \$2000:
 - Funding allowance should be based on the % increase in growth of the program
 - IP students may not be directly benefiting from this kind of program
 - There is little tracking of students, so we don't know have a direct measure of the program's outcomes
 - o *Also brought up in discussion that we need to alter the resolution criteria to assess each application/student organization fairly.
 - Historically, IPC has given MD Camp ~\$1750 (2016) and \$1300 (2017).
 - VOTE: 27 YES/1 ABSTAIN/0 NO = MOTION PASSED TO GIVE \$1531.83
 - Reasoning: this amount if proportional to their % growth from last year's program
 - Soft offer (but not a promise) for them to come back next year

Sarah Gartner II. **President Update:**

- University Senate Research Committee Changes
 - o TJ is the IPC representative
 - O Currently there are 2 graduate and 1 professional student seats
 - Previous proposal would have taken away a professional student seat.
 - Alex from CGS wants to keep 2 CGS seats, but doesn't state that he wants to maintain an IPC seat.
 - We are trying to push to keep IPC's seat.
 - Won't be able to change structure unless they get the approval from Rules Committee
 - Talk about changing quorum
 - This is a very charged committee

- Doctors in the committee wanted IPC students to say, but they are thinking about adding another faculty seat
- Interprofessional Practice and Education Initiative
 - New curriculum for all professional students (except for law)
 - Going to tailor events to make them more suited for respective schools
 - Recently received funds to revamp the program; will be instituted next year
 - New director for IPE (10 candidates so far)
 - O We want to push:
 - For a senator to sit on the committee that interviews the new director
 - To integrate with the Interprofessional Summit
- Affordability Committee Updates
 - O Collected information about tuition, fees, scholarships, loans
 - 73 survey responses (low in pharmacy)
 - Going to talk to provost in Jan/Feb
 - O HUGE discrepancy between what OSU puts on their website for tuition and fees, what they give to the IPASS database, and what you actually get billed

III. <u>Vice President Update:</u> Matt Hamrick

- Budget
 - Added MD Camp resolution
 - We would have \$3000 left if we funded all of MD Camp
 - o Reach out to more schools about presenting to IPC for next semester
- Elections

 - O Student Legal Services Olivia
 - Met in October
 - Thinking about hiring more immigration attorneys
 - Sending a survey to pass out to constituents asking: "If we hired an immigration attorney, what would you use it for?"
 - Especially pertinent for international students
 - Parking Advisory Committee Mary
 - Construction on medical side
 - Going to open up road that leads to 315
 - New E-citations rolling out

- 1st citation will be waived
- Tracked by license plate
- CampusParc going to gate garages in undergraduate campus temporarily, which is going to cost few million dollars.
 - So far, they have closed off first floor and they are considering if they should include medical campus
 - Putting up fences to prevent falls
- Board of Trustees Janice
 - Discussed the purchase of Med Center (opening Cannon garage) and transitioning into University Hospital
 - Denied UGS's resolution to the board requesting that we divest from fossil fuels
 - Heard presentation by UGS regarding Headspace app
