### **Guest Speakers**

Stefan Nguyen and another guest spoke on behalf of the Buckeye Blanket Bash. Provided us with details about the benefits of the program and their proposed numbers this year. Asked IPC for \$500 in assistance this year.

### **President Update**

Halloween was a huge success. 1257 people in attendance. Some leads still need to get money in, but over all it was great!

Fawcett center is not available on the target date we talked about for the HPS. The Blackwell hotel is going to be contacted about possibly hosting the event for us. If anyone has any suggestions about other possible locations, please let us know.

The Shoe (Stadium) was suggested and Tariq confirmed that he was planning on reaching out to a representative from the Shoe to see if they would like to host the HPS.

In terms of funding, the College of Medicine will be giving \$2,000.

The College of Vet Med will support by providing for the speaker.

IPC has budgeted for \$5000. If, after reevaluation of the budget, it seems like we need more, we will revisit the funding aspect within IPC.

Casino night: same issue. We're still looking for a place to host the event. The Blackwell got back saying that April 10<sup>th</sup> is not available. We can possibly move the event up a week. Reason why we didn't originally put it on the 3<sup>rd</sup> (a week sooner) was because of March Madness. That Friday it turns out there actually is no game this year so that wouldn't be a big issue.

Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> will be the first choice for rescheduling, we will also ask about that Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> as well.

Last year the Blackwell got great reviews in terms of choice of venue. The casino company was rated highly as well. More info on prizes as we get closer to the event.
